A school with 20 or more English learners (ELs) must have a functioning English Learner Advisory Committee (ELAC). The ELAC is responsible for advising the principal, staff, and School Site Council (SSC) on various aspects of the instructional program for ELs. In addition, the ELAC must receive information and have opportunities to provide advice/assistance on various legally-required topics.

It is important to have regular meetings at each school site and constantly be reminding/inviting parents to participate in order to establish leaders.

The "Youth Ride Free" promotional pass is now available from the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA). Using the pass, Orange County youth ages 6 to 18 can use all OC Bus fixed-route service for free starting September 2021 until February 28, 2022.

To request a Youth Ride Free pass for your child, just complete this form and return it to your child's participating school.
