

## **Works Cited Checklist**

Be sure to check off all the items below to be sure that your paper is perfectly formatted!

Works Cited must include:

\_\_\_\_1" Margins (top, left, right, bottom)

\_\_\_\_\_The words "Works Cited" centered at top of page

- \_\_\_\_\_Your last name and page number in the upper-right-hand corner (use header)
- \_\_\_\_12 point Times New Roman font
- \_\_\_\_Double spacing
- \_\_\_\_\_Hanging indent of ½ inch (default value) for each entry
- \_\_\_\_Entries in alphabetical order

\_\_\_\_\_ All titles in italics (NEW)

\_\_\_\_\_ Format tag for each entry ( NEW)

\_\_\_\_\_Each entry must be cited at least once in your document &

Each in-text citation must be referenced in the Works Cited list

Check for missing or incorrect information and for incorrect punctuation.

*Always double check your links* to be sure they work and, if the URL has been shortened, to be sure that the reader can get to the article you are citing using the information in your works cited entry!
