For our current 9-11<sup>th</sup> grade students and families, here is some very important information from our Troy High School Counselors regarding course selection for 2022-2023!

### **Attention 9-11 Grade Troy Students and Families**

*2022-2023 courses will be viewable on student Aeries portal accounts from Monday, April 18 through Friday, April 29, 2022. Once in Aeries, go to the "Classes" option and then select "Course Request(s)" to view next year's courses. Students, if you would like to request a change to your 22-23 requested classes, you must see your counselor in person during the drop-in times of before 1st period, at break, lunch, or after 6th period. The final deadline to request a change is by 3:00 PM on Friday, April 29, 2022. Requests for class changes via email or phone will not be accepted.*

*Please note that most courses are full. Students should review the registration presentations to ensure they met the course prerequisites. These presentations, along with course descriptions/profiles, can be found on the Troy counseling webpage in the '2022-2023 Course Registration & Course Profiles' section here: <https://www.fjuhsd.org/Page/600>.*

*When students return in August they will only be able to request to drop down in course levels (i.e., H/AP/IB to the lower level) if space is available or drop an additional (extra) class from their schedule. Students in grades 9-11 must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 classes and students in grade 12 must be enrolled in a minimum of 5 classes. Students, please review your 22-23 course requests and adhere to the above deadlines and process so that you may have an appropriate and balanced schedule for the next school year.*

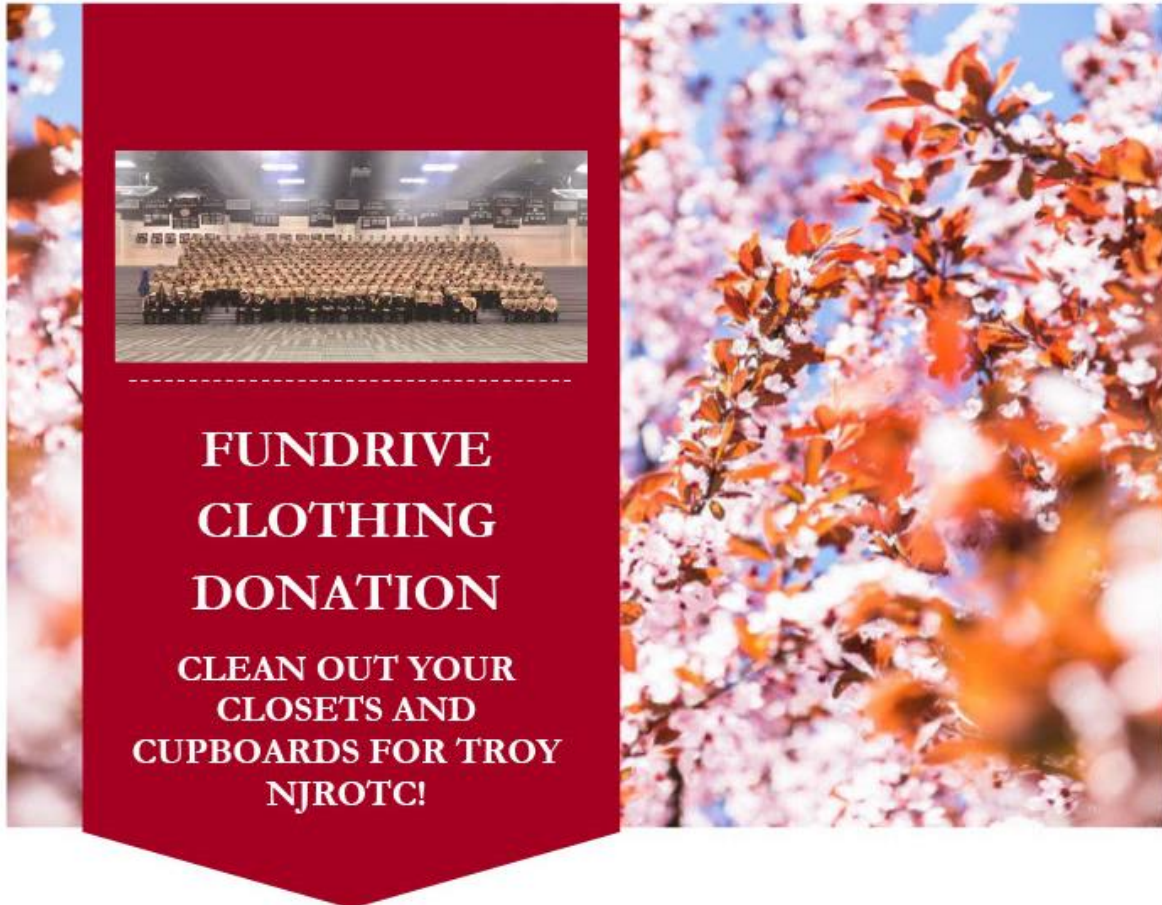

In accordance with the Center for Disease Control (CDC), CA Dept. of Public Health (CDPH), and Orange County Health Care Agency (OCHCA), we ask that you complete the Qualtrics survey each morning prior to arriving on campus. - Flu-like symptoms such as fever of 100.4 or greater
- Chills
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Runny or stuffy nose that is not associated with a pre-existing condition or other chronic health condition.
