

Troy student, Ayushi Mehrotra has done some interesting computer science work and recently arrived home from the International Science and Engineering Fair (ISEF)! It was an amazing experience and Ayushi got the chance to meet many intelligent people from different countries. Ayushi also came home with two awards: 1st place in the cybersecurity category given by the <u>National</u> <u>Security Agency</u>(\$3000!) and a fellowship called <u>Non-Trivial</u> (\$500 and up to \$15000 in funding). Her project is **ROBO057 - Detecting Attacks in Medical Deep Learning** and is very interesting. At first glance it is concerning that there would be cyber attacks in medical deep learning data. Of course the ramifications of these attacks would be highly detrimental especially as humans become more reliant upon technology to read images or data from biometric scans...

Ayushi also conveyed that she is incredibly grateful for the opportunity to represent Troy High School at the science fair and for Mr. David Kim's encouragement to pursue all my endeavors.
